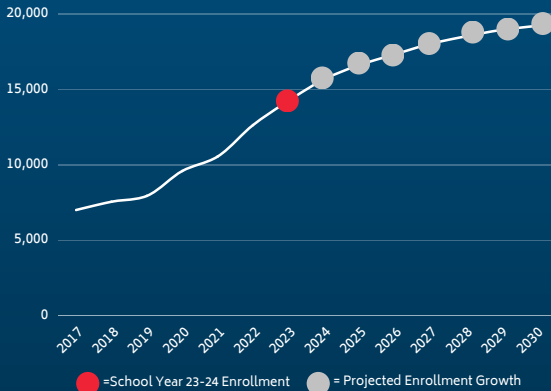


# QCUSD Bond & Override 2023
